

**AN ORDINANCE TO FORMALLY ESTABLISH A POLICE
DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City Commission to pass ordinances and regulations as a matter of public necessity, public welfare and public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, have the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City so as to protect the health and safety of its citizens, and

WHEREAS the City Commission of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, has determined that it is desirable to develop and support an active city police department;

THEREFORE, BE IT NOW ORDAINED THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, does hereby permit and authorize the formal establishment of a city police department. The City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, does also permit the hiring, training, and retention, of personnel to accomplish the objects of the police department, as is necessary.


SECTION 2. The City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, does also hereby permit a City Commission to be appointed by the Mayor to act as a Police Commissioner, in all ways that are necessary to accomplish the objects of the police department.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law, and summary publication is authorized.


