Whereas, the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Jefferson County, Kentucky, desires to petition
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to be reclassified from a 5th Class
To a 4th Class city; and,


Whereas, Kentucky Revised Statutes section 81.032 requires that the legislative body of the
City provide the General Assembly with a certified resolution requesting reclassification; and

Whereas, the City of Hurstbourne Acres will substantially comply with the requirements
as established by Section 156 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (now repealed);
and,

Whereas, the City of Hurstbourne Acres has reviewed the 2010 census information
From the United States Census Bureau, and considering the large residential population, the
number of rentals, within the City limits, and the large and varied commercial area, there are
sufficient and appropriate reasons for the change in reclassification to the fourth city, to
support this petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the legislative body of the City of Hurstbourne
Acres, Jefferson County, Kentucky officially petitions the 2012 General Assembly of the
Commonwealth of Kentucky for reclassification from the 5th class to a city of the 4th class.


